Innovation

We use a digital care planning and recording programme called

'The PASSsystem'. Your care worker will read details of your visit via an app on their mobile





phone so that this information can be read at our office. The care team will be required to complete the record keeping before leaving your home.

The PASSsystem has major advantages in comparison traditional home care record-keeping practices because information is shared in 'real time':

- As soon as we are notified of a change to your medication, we will be able to update your medication records;
- When you ask us to change your care plan, we will be able to make this change with immediate effect;
- We will know if any medications or other care tasks have not been completed by the care team. We can then find out why and get in touch to put this right.
- With your consent, the unique OpenPASS system will enable family and healthcare professionals real-time access to your care records from any location. This gives peace of mind to those who need to know that you are safe and cared for.

What services do we provide?

We offer a range of services that are designed to assist you to maintain your independence. These include:

Personal care

This includes care which could be given by a family member. For example: assisting you to get in and out of bed; washing and dressing; and assistance to meet your continence needs.

Meal preparation

All meals throughout the day can be prepared and served. Assistance can also be given to aid eating and drinking if you experience difficulty doing this independently.

Shopping, appointments and companionship

Shopping can be undertaken with you or on your behalf. We can accompany you to clinical appointments, recreational visits or provide companionship in your own home.

Medication assistance

Wherever possible, we will encourage you to maintain your independence for the administration of your medicines. However, our care team are trained to administer medication, if required.

Domestic services


We can provide help to assist with housework and other domestic tasks both as a stand-alone service or as a supplementary service as part of a larger package of support.
